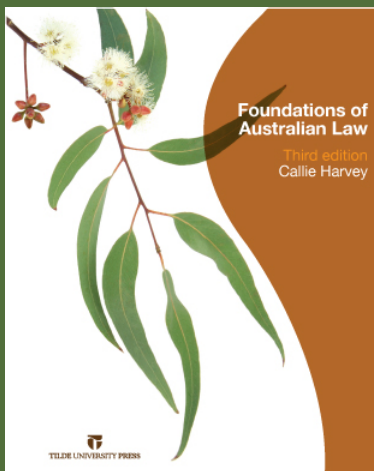
Synopsis
